Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for taking the time to read this update.

Harvest Festival:

The village church is celebrating Harvest Festival this coming weekend. In a normal year, we would have also visited the church to celebrate this important community and Christian festival. However, this year we will not be able to do this. Instead, we will mark the festival in our Friday Celebration this week. The church is collecting gifts of food for the Ashbourne Food Bank, a project managed by the Ashbourne Elim Pentecostal Church. If you wish to send in a donation of dried or tinned food with your child, we will be putting boxes by the gates at the start of the day on Thursday and Friday this week. All of your donations will be appreciated.

Pupil Update Forms:

We are sending home a Pupil Update form with your children this week. If you have not already done so, please complete these and return with your child as soon as possible so that we have fully up-to-date contact details for all children in school.

Late pupils:

We have been very pleased with how well children have adapted to our new staggered timetables. We are also thankful to all of you who have supported us through this transition. Please can I remind all parents that in the event of your child being late, parents should wait at the main entrance at 9:30 and call the office? A member of staff will come to collect your child as quickly as possible. In order to reduce children from different classes mixing, our guidance states that a child is late if they arrive more than 10 minutes after their allocated start time.

Homework:

It has been great to get homework up and running and staff are thankful for children following our guidance in returning homework books on Mondays. We do understand that this may put additional pressure on time at the weekends. If your child is unable to complete their homework tasks by Monday, please email a photograph of the work they have completed to the class teacher by Thursday morning and our teachers will endeavour to give feedback by email. Your child should then bring in their book on Friday ready to put any homework activities in ahead of the weekend.

School Improvements:

Over the coming year, we are hoping to give our school hall a face-lift. We are looking into replacing the sliding partitions and also redecorating. I have asked before, but if any of you did not see that request, we would love to hear from any of you who may have some experience or interest in interior design.
