

Piglets and Pigs Homework

Our homework expectations are as follows:

Piglets (EYFS)

Piglets are expected to read their reading book every night to a parent and their parent is to record this in the reading record. The children will also have sets of words for them to practise reading at home. The children also have spellings (up to 10) that they are to practise every week, ready for their spelling test on Friday.

Pigs (Year One)

Year One children are expected to read their reading books every night to a parent with the parent then recoding this in their reading record. They also have 10 spellings a week that they are to practise every week, ready for their spelling test on Friday. The children are also encouraged to write their spellings into sentences as this will help them to practise them as well. In the Summer Term, the children will be encouraged to practise their number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 on Top Marks, Hit The Button.

Pigs (Year Two)

Year Two children have the same expectations as Year One but with a few additional tasks, throughout the year. One of the additional tasks will be to complete a book review for their reading books, twice a week. Another task will be to start working on Times Tables Rockstars, where they will practice their 2, 5 and 10 x tables, but this will fit in with their learning on Multiplication and Division.
